Adopt a Tree – 25 new trees were adopted.

Finished Business:

- Entrance Recycle pump repaired.
- Castle repair completed (from car accident). All funds received and paid.
- An additional trash can was installed near Castle on walking trail.
- Fence 8' Variance to all properties on Appleby to install 8' fence due to elevation.

Unfinished Business:

Entrance – City has an engineer going to evaluate the pond walls and give a report.
 We've been waiting for this for several months. The board suggests Neighborhood
 Partners write a letter to the city, including invoices and estimates to escalate the repairs needed on the front entrance.

Rumble strips were considered to slow traffic traveling through the castle.

Other ideas instead:

- Digital speed limit/radar sign
- o Request a reduction of speed (25 mph) from light to stop sign
- Note: reduction of speed is needed for children crossing to and from school as well as safety in and around the Castle.

New Business:

• Green Teams would like to replace irrigation controllers with Weathermatic water smart controllers at no cost to HOA. The board requested more information before pursuing.
